

A Call to Learn and Prepare
Region 51 Emergency Management is calling for
citizens of Lincoln County to attend the Community Emergency Response Team training
class. The CERT Program educates people about disaster preparedness and trains them in basic disaster response skills, such as fire safebasic lisaster response skills, such as life sale-ty, light search and rescue, and disaster medical operations. Using this training, citizens will learn how to prepare for disasters ahead of time, and what to do if there is an incident.

While it is not required, all citizens taking this within it is not required, air clazers saving training will have the opportunity to join the Lin-coln County CERT Team. CERT volunteers will have opportunities to participate in disaster exer-cises, promote emergency preparedness at community events, and respond to disasters in coordination with emergency responders in our area, helping their neighborhood or workplace.
