Choice Gas Selection ~ April 2-22

The 2026 Nebraska Choice Gas program selection period will run from April 2 through April 22. During this period, natural gas customers can choose their natural gas supplier and pricing option for the upcoming gas year, which begins June 1 and runs through May 31, 2027.

ACE remains as the only community-owned natural gas supplier in the program and is in its 28th year as a competing supplier. At the direction of the ACE Board of Directors, ACE returns money to its member communities, which includes Brady. ACE has returned more than \$6,000 to Brady for community betterment use.
