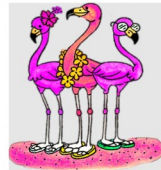

§ 130.28 FIRECRACKERS.

It shall be unlawful for any person
to ignite or cause to be exploded
fireworks or firecrackers of any
description whatsoever within the
municipality, except permissible
fireworks annually listed and
promulgated by the
State Fire Marshal.

Fireworks may lawfully be
shot off June 25-July 3 from
10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. each
day and July 4 from
10:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m.
