

CHAPTER 10

BUSINESS REGULATIONS

ARTICLE 3. TOBACCO LICENSES

10-301 TOBACCO LICENSES; GENERALLY. It shall be unlawful for any person, partnership or corporation to sell, keep for sale or give away in the course of trade any cigars, tobacco, cigarettes or cigarette material to anyone without first obtaining a license from the Municipal Clerk. Said applicant shall file a written application stating the name of the applicant, exact location of the place of business and shall deposit with such application a license fee in the amount as stated in Chapter 12 of this ordinance. Said license shall then be issued by the Municipal Clerk and the license fee transferred to the local school district. (Ref. 28-1421 through 28-1429 RS Neb.)

10-302 TOBACCO LICENSES; FOR SALE; APPLICATION; CONTENTS; FEE. Every person, partnership, limited liability company, or corporation desiring a license to sell tobacco at retail shall file with the Municipal Clerk a written application, on forms provided by the Municipality, stating the name of the person, partnership, limited liability company, or corporation for whom the license is desired and the exact location of the place of business and shall deposit with the application a license fee in the amount of ten dollars (\$10.00). If the applicant is an individual, the application shall include the applicant's social security number. (Ref. 28-1422, 28-1423 RS Neb.)
