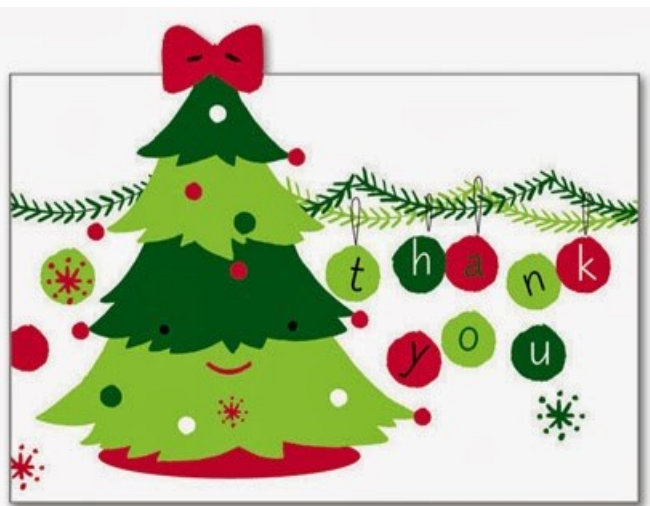
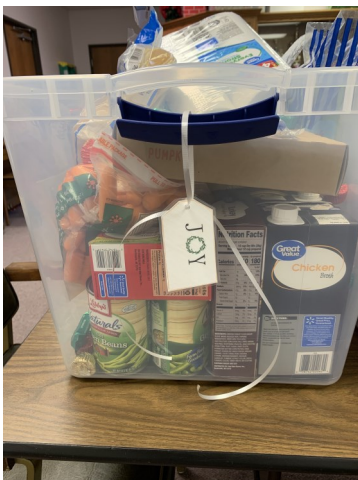
## Adult Classes at Brady Library
