Fireworks may lawfully be shot off beginning June 25th and ending July 3rd of each year from 10:00 am to 10:00 pm each day; and on July 4th of each year from 10:00 A.M. to 11:59 P.M.

These filings must be done prior to July 15, 2020 for incumbents and August 1, 2020 for non-incumbents.
