§ 130.28 FIRECRACKERS.

It shall be unlawful for any person to ignite or cause to be exploded fireworks or firecrackers of any description whatsoever within the municipality, except sparklers, Vesuvius fountains, spray fountains, torches, color fire cones, star and comet type color aerial shells without explosive charges for the purpose of making a noise, color wheels, lady fingers not exceeding seven-eighths inch in length or one-eighth inch in diameter and which do not contain more than one-half grain each in weight of explosive material. Fireworks may lawfully be shot off beginning June 25 and ending July 3 of each year from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. each day and on July 4 of each year from 10:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m.

Brady Ordinance concerning

ATV operation:

§ 72.06 ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES.

(3) An all-terrain vehicle may be operated as authorized in division (B)(2) above when such operation occurs only between the hours of sunrise and sunset. Any person operating an all-terrain vehicle as authorized in division (B)(2) above shall have a valid Class O operator's license or a farm permit, as provided in Neb. RS 60-4,126, shall have liability insurance coverage for the all-terrain vehicle while operating the all-terrain vehicle on highway, and shall not operate such vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 mph. The person operating the all-terrain vehicle shall provide proof of such insurance coverage to any peace officer requesting such proof within five days of such a request. When operating an all-terrain vehicle as authorized in division (B)(2) above, the headlight and taillight of the vehicle shall be on and the vehicle shall be equipped with a bicycle safety flag which extends not less than five feet above ground attached to the rear of such vehicle. The bicycle safety flag shall be triangular in shape with an area of not less than 30 square inches and shall be a day-glow in color.
