## **General Election~~ November 3, 2020**

It's that time of year to start thinking about the election on November 3, 2020. The Village of Brady will have three vacancies for the Board of Trustees. Pursuant to Nebraska Revised Statute 32-615, any candidate pursuing a write-in campaign shall file a notarized affidavit of his or her intent together with the receipt for any filing fee. Deadline for write-in candidates to file notarized affidavit and pay the \$12.00 filing fee is October 23, 2020. Filing the write-in affidavit is the only way a write-in candidate can get his or her name on the ballot. If you are interested, you will need to pay a \$12.00 filing fee at the Village Office and take that receipt and notarized affidavit to the Lincoln County Clerk/Election Commissioner to be added on the

November 3 ballot.


